

CITY OF ALAMEDA RESOLUTION NO. _____

AUTHORIZING NAMING THE JEAN SWEENEY OPEN SPACE PARK
GROUP PICNIC PAVILION THE ALAMEDA ROTARY PAVILION

WHEREAS, the Rotary Club of Alameda offered a donation to fund the construction of the group picnic pavilion at Jean Sweeney Open Space Park; and

WHEREAS, the project provides additional funding for the park construction; and

WHEREAS, the Alameda Rotary Club is a strong community partner and will receive recognition for its significant financial contribution; and

WHEREAS, per the 2007 City Council authorized policy for naming City property, facilities and streets, this is allowable under the criteria for a name that recognizes the donor of a significant gift of funds for a City facility; and

WHEREAS, on October 13, 2016, the Recreation and Park Commission recommended this naming and agreed that it is appropriate to include the Rotary name and logo on a permanent recognition feature on the picnic pavilion as a way to recognize their donation and to Jean Sweeney Open Space Park; and

WHEREAS, the Rotarians have voted and confirmed that the Rotary Club will donate \$100,000 to the construction of the group picnic pavilion. An agreement between the Rotary Club of Alameda and the City of Alameda provides a framework for the donation. This agreement includes opportunities for Rotary to reserve, at no cost, the picnic pavilion up to six times per year; and payment of \$100,000 to the City in equal installments over a five year period beginning in Fiscal Year (FY) 2016-17; and

WHEREAS, the \$100,000 donation will be received over a five-year period and will be recorded in the Capital Improvement Program Budget, Jean Sweeney Open Space Park Project 91309.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Alameda hereby:

Authorizes naming the Jean Sweeney Open Space Park group picnic pavilion the Alameda Rotary Pavilion.
